A high overcast and a light breeze helped create an ideal warm summer weekend for Warbird rides, TBM wing-walk, tours and PX Sales at the Uintah County Fair in Vernal, Utah this past weekend. We teamed up our Stearman with the Rocky Mountain Wing, who flew their J-3 Cub and Grumman TBM Avenger from Grand Junction to the event.

After landing at the airport, the TBM was towed through narrow airport gates, through town accompanied by police escort, to the gates of the fairgrounds. She then spread her wings, attracting nearly every visitor to come see and learn about the aircraft. Hundreds, if not thousands, of people of all ages stood in awe of this magnificent aircraft, climbed on the wings to see the cockpit, conversed with the ground crew and pilots, purchased toys or mementos of the experience, and left with a greater understanding of our nations proud aviation heritage.

A number of lucky fair-goers also signed up to take a ride in our historic aircraft. Over the course of the weekend, we provided 7 Cub rides, 6 Stearman rides, and 3 TBM rides.
